A Letter From The Chairman

Information from Ronnie Ireland about the new website

Hello Artists

As I pen these lines, we are just waiting for the last parts of the website to be tested and soon we can go live. (This will come as a great relief to those of you who are desperate to pay your subscription I know.)

I think the main responsibility of the Chairman/Person is for the overall direction of the Society. This means putting it on a sound footing creatively and financially for the coming years. The new website is central to this. What do we see it doing?

- 1 It can be a forum for our thoughts, discoveries and activities It can give us a greater sense of belonging to something strong that is moving forward and will help to challenge each one of us to be more creative. All this is possible IF WE ACTUALLY USE IT!
- 2 We don't have the resources human and financial to do things the old way. Paper print and post is very time intensive and expensive with nearly 400 members and since few people have/want to give the time to do it all, we need another solution. The solution is to go digital for all things. It is already the way everything is going and we are only catching up. To attract the fabled new younger membership, it is crucial they will expect nothing less. It will give us quicker, more accurate, more extensive information. Most art societies are stuck in the past we cannot afford to be.
- 3 Three simple alternatives as I see it:-
 - A Change nothing in a few years there will be no Society we will be broke.
 - B Keep it cheap and cheerful we will become a "hobby" society nothing wrong with those as they are very important. For FAS it would mean a huge fall off in quantity and of course quality of membership. Not a future that I want to be a part of let alone promote.
 - C Be positive lead the way and become bigger and better Make the annual show something that people want to see and look forward to. After that there could be other Member activities which will raise the profile of the Society and the Membership. This means a greater involvement from a greater number of members, but it will also create greater opportunities for us all.

The plan is for all aspects of the Society to be done via the website for the start of the next membership year i.e. September 2016. This is great timing as we will be coming up for the 70th Exhibition and that should be marked as something special. We welcome any thoughts about that as to how we can celebrate that achievement in any way (I'm already planning the Party!).

That's enough for now - I simply exhort all of you to support our future wholeheartedly - that will move the Society on to a new level - and maybe surprise us all by what we can achieve!
