CALL FOR ENTRIES

Please ensure you have carefully read the full entry rules, terms and conditions on the FAS website before submitting your entry.

As you know, it is extremely complicated to stage an exhibition of this size and whilst every effort will be made to hang all accepted artwork, it may not be possible to do so. FARNHAM ART SOCIETY reserves the right to decide which pieces will be hung.

Fees: **£10.00** for each item of artwork that is accepted and commission of 25% of all sales made, to cover the cost of the Exhibition including credit card fees. (A) Associate members 1 free entry and (H) Honorary members (3 free entries) allowed in the condition of entry.

Two-dimensional works for the main exhibition: £10

1 large painting (Over 100 cm in any direction) accepted per member. (Larger pieces, unglazed ONLY, may be acceptable subject to the artist providing their own easel to which their art work can be safely and securely anchored.) If glazed please contact FAS.

2D works up to 100cm in any direction can be entered. 3 paintings accepted for (N)non exhibiting member.

4 paintings accepted for (E)exhibiting member.

Three- Dimensional works: Sculpture: £10 per item(up to 6 items)

Ceramics/Glass £10.per item (up to 6 items) N:B (3 small items of lower value £50 or below classed as 1 Item)

Folios/Prints: £2.00 per item.

Up to 3 folios maybe entered for display in a FAS browser. IMPORTANT: Please notes rules about prints on the FAS Website. Only Original prints allowed. Reproduction prints NOT permitted.

LARGE EXHIBITS 3D. If your exhibit is extra large or heavy please contact Alan Wallis @ farnhamartsociety@outlook.com with advance information.

LABELLING: All pieces should be labelled on the back, with old labels removed. An additional label should be attached to a piece of STRING/CORD which can be pulled forward to the front of the artwork, once it is hung, to check all details.

EACH PIECE MUST BE WELL STRUNG OR IT WILL NOT BE INCLUDED. ALL ARTWORK MUST BE PRESENTED CLEAN AND IN PERFECT ORDER SUMMARY of Terms and Conditions for Selection:

ALL EXHIBITORS must be fully paid up members and required to provide a completed entry form and provide times when they are available to steward.

- 1. Insurance: Farnham Art Society holds a Public Liability Insurance only. This covers our responsibility in case an accident happens to the public in our events. Exhibitors must be aware that this does not include theft or damage to any of the exhibits, nor can the venue be held responsible for this and this insurance is the responsibility of the artist /sculptor /ceramicist/printer.
- 2. Quality of work: All work supplied must be of saleable quality. Poor work will not be accepted. All exhibitors must be aware that they are responsible for their work to each purchaser and must refund or replace the work if found to be defective in materials or workmanship. After sales care for each piece sold must be supplied to each purchaser. Also certificates of Sculptures must be supplied to each purchaser if required.
- 3. Setting Up: The artwork 2D & 3D will be placed by Farnham Art Society.
- 4. Sculpture /Ceramics/Paintings: No exhibitor may move exhibits unless agreed with Farnham Art Society's permission.
- 5. Plinths: Sculptors are expected to supply a plinth for their exhibits if required. Please contact Alan Wallis.
- 6. Safety: Artists must ensure that their work is safe to hang or securely anchored to their plinth (Health and Safety requirement).
- 7. Publicity: All work exhibited may be photographed for publicity purposes.
- 8. Unlimited works or Editions: They must not exceed 100 copies.
- 9. Unique Artwork and Sculptures: Substitutions will be allowed through contact with Farnham Art Society.
- 10. Selection: Selection is final and Farnham Art Society reserves the right not to hang or place an artwork if condition of work is faulty.
- 11. After Sales: After Sales as the result of exhibiting a sculpture or artwork is still subject to a 25% commission charge.
- **12.** Removal: No removal of exhibits by the artist is permitted unless approved by prior agreement.
- 13. Collection: All unsold artworks MUST be collected from the exhibition or will incur a storage cost.
